Tell me about a time you did something wrong and how did you handle it?

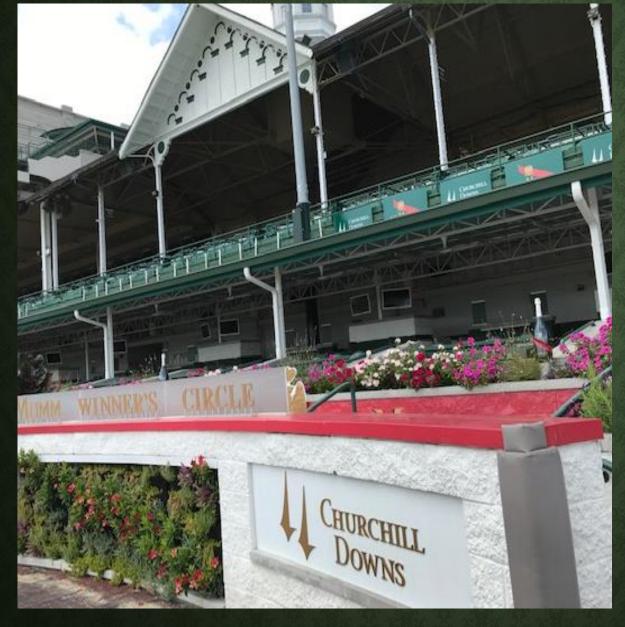
